Auction closes on the 15th October 2023

Firstly, an apology for a complete mis-representation of Lot 21 in the last auction. As a postal history collector with little real interest in stamps, I was misled by the fact that the 1967 Christmas issue of stamps was the ONLY one (that I now know of) that was issued on two separate dates six weeks apart. So, it wasn't an amazing pre-cancel item but just a normal FDC of the 4d stamp. Blushes!

On offer today is another good selection of GB TPOs with more related ephemera to create extra interest in a TPO display/collection together with a small but interesting batch of Irish TPOs and a varied offering of paquebot and maritime marks.
