TPO & Seapost Society Auction Spring 2024

Auction closes on the 15th April 2024

Yet another offering of TPO and many more Seapost items just arrived. A few reminders of the abbreviations used in the listing may be of interest. **Cvr** = cover; **pc** = postcard; **pspc** = postal stationery postcard, **ps** = postal stationery, **canc** = cancelled; **sc** or **cds** = single circle; **dc** = double circle; **b/s** or **b/stamp** = backstamp. W numbers from H Wilson, RS numbers are from Roberts & Stubbs & M&D numbers are from Morris & Dovey. The star ratings at the end of each listing are my attempt to indicate the quality of the TPO or Seapost strike and NOT for the overall condition of the cover or card. Please ask for scans if you are unsure.

| 3 | GB Two unaddressed manilla envelopes cancelled 30mm rubber datestamps MIDLAND SOUTH (Prelim) / BT (RS1815) 12 DEC 1988 and NORTH EASTERN DOWN / BT (RS1839) 13 DEC 1984 both struck in red ink 5* & 4* | £5 |
| 4 | GB Similar items cancelled NORTH WESTERN DOWN / BT (RS1854) 21 DEC 1989, CARLISLE – EDINBURGH / BT (RS1852) 12 DEC 1989 and CREWE PETERBOROUGH / BT (RS1834) 22 DEC 1989 all in red ink 5*+, 4*+ and 5*+ | £8 |
| 5 | GB Card with 6 Scottish TPO marks on piece, stamp (1) or cutout (1) – Glasgow-Carlisle duplex code 1 x2 both 1872 (W730): Glasgow-Carlisle duplex code 1 (W731) 1874 and code 8 on stamp 1881: Glasgow Carlisle duplex code E (W738) 1891 & dc Edinr & Carlisle / ST (W695) code D 1892 on cutout. All 5* strikes except the code 8 on a 2½d plate 21 which is 4*+ but incomplete | £6 |
| 6 | GB Similar card with 8 Northern TPO marks – Gt Northern/TPO/Midday Mail Down (W614a) but mid height stop after Midday: 1896 on cutout: similar (W615) 1910: Edinr & Newcastle ST Day Mail code U ((W783); dc London-York-Edinburgh /Rly SC (W576) 1928; similar with larger arcs 1923; sc London-York-Edinburgh TPO (W579a) x2 but different 1932 & 1934 & stamp with incomplete North Western TPO /Night Down thimble (W28b?) 1904 5* x4 & 4*+ x3 and 4* | £6 |
| 7 | GB Card with NW TPO related marks on piece (3), cutout (3) and stamp (2) W198, W164 thin arc, W28b, - W22, W60a, W64b, - W186 and W198. Marks on the 2 stamps are partial 4* to 5* | £5 |
| 8 | GB Manilla envelope size DL addressed but unstamped and undated with oval stamp with centre crown LONDON CENTRAL TRANSPORT / T.P.O. SECTION (RS1762. Possibly for use on display open days???? 5*- | £5 |
| 9 | IRELAND comic postcard 'Kissing the Blarney Stone' addressed to Southampton with stamp cancelled sc G. S & W. T.P.O /NIGHT code 'U' (W858a) AU 19 04 5++ | £18 |



- 10 GB **CARDIFF-GLASGOW T.P.O. and vv. No.1 and No.2.** Full set of four handstamps used on the last nights of operation 8-9th May 2003. These examples were struck on the trains and were notoriously poorly struck on the night. All are readable but are not perfect unlike those struck at TPO section which were never anywhere near the train. About 4* to -4*+ £5
- 11 **CARLISLE – PETERBOROUGH TPO No 1** 1992 (W205c) and **No. 2** 2x (W205d different size dates 1992 – 3) and **PETERBOROUGH CARLISLE TPO / No 1** (W205g) 1992. All 5*+ £5
- 12 Official sheet **Farewell to the Peterborough-Crewe TPOs / Last Night of Service** with 5 covers viz. 1965-91 dc **CREWE-PETERBOROUGH T.P.O. (W88a)** First run 6 JU 85; similar for 27 JU 90 plus 3 covers for the last trip on 27 SP 91 - **PETERBOROUGH – CREWE (W88j & two LINC. SECT. covers (W88b and 88d). - 14 FRANCE 1902. 04 & 09 Four similar cards to Lot 13 viz **St MALO a RENNES, SALON d'HYERES a TOULON, AGEN a TOULOUSE and COURTALAIN a NOGENT LE ROTROU** 4*+. Three others with incomplete strikes included £6
- 15 FRANCE.1863 cross border TPO entry mark in orange ink reading **SUISSE AMB. M. CENIS** struck on the front of an entire from Lausanne in Switzerland addressed to Marseille. Poorish b'stamps of Geneva, LYON a MARSEILLE and Lausanne 5*- £8
- 16 FRANCE 1856 Entire from a perfumier in Rouen to another in Paris backstamped with a superb dc **LE HAVRE A PARIS 3*/B** for the night mail dated 12 JUL 56. Said to be a scarce 'reserve' brigade mark in Pothion 5* £10
- 17 FRANCE Interesting entire from Bayonne addressed to Oloron misstruck to the day **BORDEAUX A BAYONNE 2° TPO** on 25 Sept 63. It should not have gone north! There is also a NIGHT mark for the same **2° TPO** dated 26 Sept 63 as well as a **BAYONNE A BORDEAUX 1° day** mark for 27 SEPT 63. These marks valued in the 100+ euro bracket in 1998 4*+, 5* & 4* £10
- 18 GB 1903 Greek postcard '*Souvenir d'Athenes*' addressed to Ayr. Stamp has been removed but does not show too badly with alongside a superb sc **CARLISLE & AYR / SORTING TENDER** code 'D' (W756) AP 13 03 5*+ £15
- 19 GB 1933 small cover to Glasgow with 3 x 1/2d stamps cancelled 3 strikes sc **AYR-CARLISLE / R.S.C.** (W760) 30 JU 33 5* £9
- 20 GB 1892 unstamped cover addressed to Wallington from a James Ferguson with a fine sc **CARLISLE & AYR / SORTING TENDER** code 'B' (W755) JY 11 92. The 'B' code is wide and set high. Wilson records this to 1892 so a late date! 5* £19

- 36 GB Penny lilac cover Chester to Glasgow backstamped **GLASGOW / SORTING TENDER** (as W718d) code '6*' JY 31 86 struck through cloth '-TING' is a little faint. 3* £5
- 37 GB1868 blue cover London-Glasgow b/stamped 22.5mm sc **3* / GLASGOW** (W717) JY 23 68. Neat and looking new? 5* £5
- 38 GB1852 entire from London to Leek via Newcastle, Staffs with Grand Northern Railway sc **E/NR** (W5) on front. London PAID and '1' in pale orange also on front. Railway mark is a little blurry to LHS 4*+ £9

- 40 GB1913 real photo postcard of '*Richard 1 Statue, London*' addressed to Malvern with 1d GV stamp cancelled sc **GREAT-WESTERN. T.P.O / GOING-WEST** (W331a) code 'E' JU 14 13 5*- £5
