TPO Society Auction Winter 2020

Here is another offering to tempt your wallet and give you something more to do during the easing, or is it now escalation, of the lockdown.

Auction opens on 15th December 2020 and closes on the 15th January 2021

Having now reviewed the last two auctions, it seems that, following a number of comments, there may be a requirement to 'reinvent' the bidding form which will now be placed in the relevant journal for those who prefer to use it. My personal preference would be for members to use email to send in their bids or requests for scans as this is quicker and cheaper than by ordinary mail. I will always try to quickly acknowledge any bids sent to me in this way so that you know your bids have arrived and been logged in. If you send your bids in via the traditional method, it is important that you include your address and phone number (and email address if you have one) to enable quicker contact at the end of the sale.

In addition, I have tried to offer a grading system to indicate the quality of the postmark. This is my own interpretation based on experience but I must state that it is only an opinion and I do make mistakes so please, bear with me. This is based on a system of 1* through to 5* with a + or – if I think it is warranted. Again, this is solely MY interpretation.

Items for the auction are always welcome especially seapost material as we seem to be targeting the TPO side of the Society's interests. This is simply due to the material I have been offered to auction and is not deliberate in any way.

The 'First Come, First Served' section of the auction has been shelved due to some duplication of the offerings to the members by the Society.
