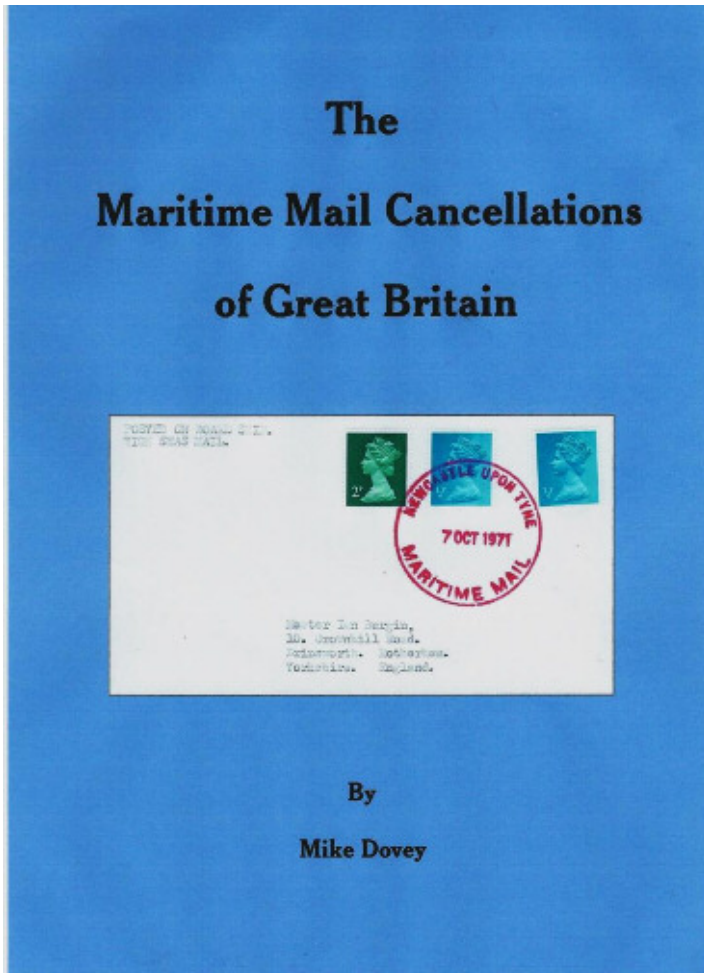


A New Publication published by the Society.

The Maritime Mail Cancellations **of Great Britain.**



In the beginning there was Robertson who wrote the gigantic book on Ship Letters while much later there was the Hosking book on Paquebot marks which he stretched to three editions. In the middle was a valiant attempt by Colin Tabcart to update Robertson and added as many maritime mail marks that could be found at the time while the final book on paquebot marks by Dovey & Morris did little to advance the subject of maritime marks.

This has now been rectified.

When the N67 cancel for London in the Robertson series began to stretch to 10 variations, then 20, then 30 there was a sudden rush of blood to the head and a need to bring the whole subject of maritime marks to the front instead of being the Cinderella subject it has been for so long. Even the Newcastle upon Tyne cover shown here and dated 1971 was undiscovered until 2011 some 40 years later as no-one had really delved into the subject. With luck this has now been put right and there is now a book that fills the middle ground in the world of maritime philately.

With Christmas coming on this book is the perfect present for any collector. Got a birthday? Then this book fills the gap. A present for the Wife? Here we go, make her day!
